Our goal is to improve opportunities for people at every level, by connecting Mentees with Mentors who can share their knowledge and experience to give guidance. We emphasise that mentorships are not to be confused with free of charge consultation or private tuition. The bulk of Mentees ask for portfolio, career, or educational guidance. Some Mentees simply look for a sounding board or an opportunity to discuss type related topics, and understand how they can get more involved in the wider community. Periodically, we check in to ensure everyone is still happy with the arrangement and encourage both the Mentor and the Mentee to contact us if the relationship is not working for some reason.

Since Alphettes supports and promotes the work of all women in our fields, every pairing centres a women (trans, intersex and cis) nonbinary, agender and gender variant people as Mentee and a Mentor (any gender). We may fast-track pairings for underrepresented groups. Specific needs for Mentors or Mentees may be accommodated upon request, such as woman-to-woman pairings.
